summits; mountaineers; highlanders.

Perizzite (Perizzites), per'-;z-zite (fr. Heb.)-countryman; rustic; dweller in the country.

Hivite, hiõ-vite (fr. Heb.)--animation; physical existence; life born of effort; bestiality; wickedness; villager; mid-lander.

Jebus, je'-bus (Heb.)--trodden down; trampled under foot; a threshing floor conquered; subjected; utterly subdued, laid waste; contemptuous; profaned; polluted. Jebusite (in A. V., Joshua 18:16, 28, Jebusi; Genesis 15:21 Jebusites), jebõ-u-site (fr. Heb. Jebusi)--of or belonging to Jebus.
